ALIENTE believes that these projects cannot be considered to be of common interest, as they jeopardise the success of the energy transition. A transition that, in order to effectively combat the climate crisis, must take into account the limits of the planet, protect biodiversity and make the most of the possibilities offered by renewable sources to democratise access to energy.

Why?

⚡ Because they promote extractivism and colonialism, by accumulating environmental and social damage in rural territories, that are considered "sacrificiable", and are far from the urban and industrial areas that concentrate energy demand.

⚡ Because they disregard the objective of sustainability by over-dimensioning energy needs, without measuring the material resources required for its generation, discouraging energy saving and reducing the resilience of the system.

⚡ Because it maintains the same energy model and in the hands of the same operators who are causing the climate crisis that it aims to combat, with the incorporation of renewable sources into the system as its sole change

⚡ Because they will exacerbate social injustice, reducing the price of electricity in importing countries, while increasing it in those that produce it such as Spain, where the electricity market will continue to be managed by an oligopoly.

⚡ Because, in the same way that interconnections allow greater integration of renewable energies, they can also transport nuclear and fossil energy, distributing dirty electricity throughout Europe.
